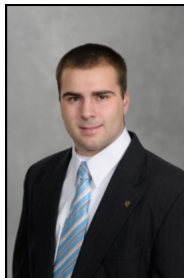


Peggy Accordino, chairwoman of the Spencer Educational Foundation, with the 2013 first-place team from Temple University

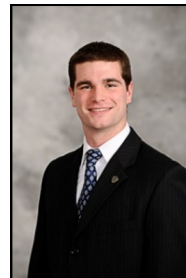
The second annual VCU case competition was held on Monday, March 4, 2013 and Tuesday, March 5, 2013 and hosted by Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, VA as part of the VCU Risk and Insurance Studies Center Conference, an annual event that spotlights emerging trends and critical issues in the insurance field. 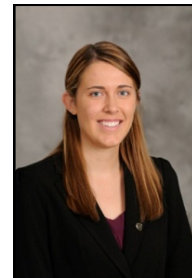
