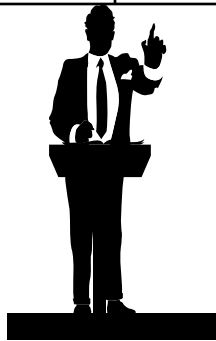
INTERVIEW WORKSHOPS INTERNSHIP CANDIDATES

IN MEMORY OF DR. H. WAYNE SNIDER (1923 – 1999)

This semester, the weekly presentations are being dedicated to a legend of risk management education. Dr. H. Wayne Snider founded the Risk Management Department in 1963 and pioneered the development of risk management theory and practice. During his academic career, he had a profound influence on thousands of students, including many leaders of today's risk management and insurance field.

Prior to coming to Temple University, Dr. Snider held teaching positions at the University of Washington, Illinois Wesleyan University, and the University of Pennsylvania. He is remembered by his students as both a demanding instructor and effectual mentor, generous with his time. His influence on the careers of his students is felt throughout the risk management profession.
