“NIKE’S UNIQUE RISK MANAGEMENT ISSUES”

In its 30 years of operation, Nike has truly become a global brand. The company has established manufacturing, distribution, marketing, and retail sales operations all over the world, with over \$7 billion in physical assets.

Mr. Beeghly, who joined Nike in 1996, is responsible for mitigating the risks faced by the global organization in every aspect of business and product management. Mr. Beeghly currently manages over \$30 million in annual premiums, across all lines: property, liability, automobile, marine/cargo, aviation, executive risk, crime, employment practices liability, and special risk. In addition, the company also manages a wholly owned “captive” property and casualty insurance subsidiary underwriting over \$7 million in net annual premiums.

Mr. Beeghly has a wide range of duties that touch, as risk management does, every aspect of the organization. During his presentation this Wednesday, Mr. Beeghly will describe some of the factors that make his job unique, and illustrate to students and faculty how he manages one of the greatest jobs in risk management for a sports enthusiast.
