Shari Kendall is an attorney for the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety in Arlington, Virginia. She has been with the Institute since 2000. The Institute is a nonprofit, independent, scientific and educational organization dedicated to reducing the losses – deaths, injuries, and property damage – from crashes on the nation's highways. The Institute is wholly supported by auto insurers. Ms. Kendall's responsibilities include tracking state and federal legislation, regulations, and other governmental concerns, as well as legal research and corporate legal matters (contracts, licenses, etc.). She has worked extensively on a variety of motor vehicle safety issues, including automated enforcement (camera enforcement of red light and speed violations), DUI/DWI, occupant restraint laws, helmet laws, driver licensing, and laws and regulations dealing with the emerging issues of low-speed vehicles and event data recorders. She has a strong interest in federal regulatory issues dealing with vehicles and highway safety.

Ms. Kendall is a graduate of Brandeis University (B.A) and the George Mason University School of Law (J.D.). She is admitted to practice law in Virginia.
