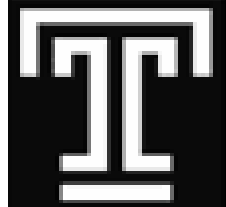

This is a great opportunity for actuarial science majors to hear industry professionals discuss the importance of passing the exams.

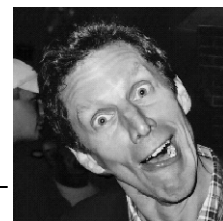
Speakers will be discussing test taking strategies, studying strategies, and material on the exams.
