Private Pensions and Social Security are two topics that will affect all of us at some time in our lives. Sources of retirement income have been very hot topics in the news lately, with the threat of dwindling Social Security funds, and the recent Enron and Worldcom bankruptcies. Dr. Mitchell has been very influential in the efforts to secure private pensions, and shore up social security as well. Working with the Pension Research Council at the University of Pennsylvania, Dr. Mitchell and her colleagues have a formidable effect on public policy effecting retirement income. Dr. Mitchell has provided consultation to the United States Department of Labor, the Social Security Administration, the General Accounting Office, and the Treasury. She has also been a force for pension reform in the international arena, working with the Japanese Government and the World Bank. among other entities.
