David Fields is President of AIG Risk Finance. Previously, he was Senior Vice President of Underwriting for the division. From January 1994 through September 1995, he was with AIG Risk Management as the Senior Vice President of Underwriting and Chief Actuary. Prior to joining the AIG companies, Dave was Chief Underwriting Officer and Director for Lincoln National Specialty Insurance Company and K&K. He had been in the AIG Companies' Corporate Actuarial Department from 1982-91 as an Assistant Actuary with responsibility for various AIG member companies. Dave graduated from Rutgers University in 1977 with a BA in Physics.

Dan McGinnis is Assistant Vice President - Structural Underwriting for AIG Risk Finance. Prior to joining the AIG companies, he led the Advanced Risk Solutions practice for Marsh of Philadelphia. Prior to that he worked for the Enterprise Risk division of Marsh in both New York and San Francisco. He began his career in 1995 with a predecessor company of Marsh, where he managed several large, share-price sensitive, risk financing projects for large publicly traded firms. The transactions range in scope from environmental liability buyouts to the structuring and marketing of custom option structures. Dan earned his BBA from Temple University in Risk Management and Insurance and Economics.
