Anthony Avitabile is responsible for Major League Baseball's (MLB's) League-wide Insurance program (the "Program") for all 30 MLB Clubs and their baseball related entities, as well as MLB's central office entities, including an Internet company, a Productions company, a Ticketing company and a Network.

Since 2003 MLB has saved over \$80MM in insurance costs. Aside from aggressive renewal negotiations and maintaining key insurance carrier and vendor relationships, this was achieved through innovative risk management efforts, including the implementation of education/training programs for the Clubs and the introduction of Quality Councils in the critical areas of Workers' Compensation and General Liability that meet no less than annually to discuss best practices and

and hot industry topics.

Anthony is responsible for MLB's Vermont-based captive insurance company (MLB BASES), whose board includes seven Club CFOs that set policy and makes key decisions for the Program. Anthony also manages a Large Claims Committee composed of a subset of captive board members and lawyers to review potential high exposure matters early in the claim life-cycle.

Prior to joining MLB, Anthony held various risk management positions at Ingersoll-Rand Company and Metropolitan Life Insurance Company. Anthony currently serves on advisory boards for FM Global, Willis, ACE and the AMA, and was a keynote speaker at RIMS Hawaii 2006.

Prior to his tenure at Marsh, Henry ran the European arm of a US-headquartered venture capital fund with minority equity investment positions in early stage software and financial services businesses.

A GE Capital alumni, Henry served in a number of senior leadership roles within the financial services divisions of

of General Electric, advancing through several mergers and acquisitions roles within GE Capital, culminating as the Strategic Business Development Director across Europe for GE Capital European Equipment Finance.
