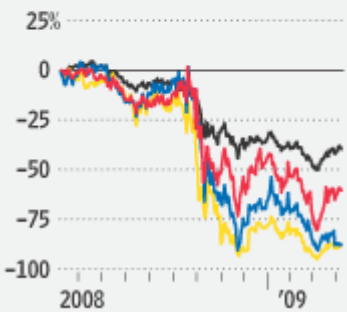

LIFE INSURERS LATEST TO RECEIVE AID: U.S. TO OFFER TARP MONEY TO TROUBLED FIRMS

Life insurance companies in the United States may be next in line to receive bailout money from the Federal Government. The Treasury Department is expected to announce an expansion of the Troubled Asset Relief Program (TARP) within the next several days. Several large life insurance companies have seen stock prices tumble by up to 40% over the past several months.

The life insurance is an important part of the overall U.S. financial system. Millions of Americans have money tied up in life insurance contracts. If too many of these policy holders lose faith in the insurance companies and began to cash out their policies, the insurance companies—who invest significant amounts in securities—would be forced to close out positions in many of these markets. Such a liquidation could cause a downturn in these markets.

The life insurance industry represents a third major industry that the Treasury has chosen as bailout recipients. Only insurers that own federally chartered banks will qualify for the TARP money. The amount of money that the insurers would have access to is still unclear, but the Treasury has said that it has roughly \$130 billion of TARP money remaining.

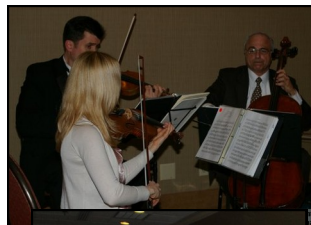

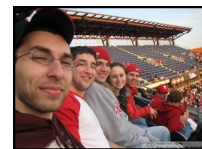
